We have provided over **80** one to one support through our employment, foodbank, training and call support services.

Impact of our food delivery services this month;

- **70** families and **8** individuals were served.
- **660kg** of food. This is equivalent to
- **699** meals equivalent, and
- **2112kg** of Carbon dioxide savings.
