OUR WORK IN THE COMMUNITY

We have provided over **272** one-to-one support through our employment, food bank, transport, and wellbeing activities.

Foodbank

The foodbank service hit the ground running this month making an impact of;

- 42 families and 3 individuals were served.
- 1391 kg of food. This is equivalent to 3312 meals equivalent, and
- 4451 kg of Carbon dioxide savings.

The team supported a family of 5 who were in isolation with food bank delivery to their home. The family was beyond grateful as they could not access food services until a much later date.

Community Transport

After 6 months of serving the community through the CT, we have worked with **84** participants with **615** total engagements!

- **192** Engagements
- 16 participants supported through the wellbeing services.

The walk and talk sessions have actively been combating the stigma associated with men struggling from mental related issues.

Refugee Women Empowerment (RWE)

This service has delivered **12** one to one services this month.

Individuals received:

- · Job coaching
- CV writing and interview preparation
- Training support

The project has gained the attention of the home office and had a fantastic strategy meeting. We would also like to congratulate the 7 participants who achieved certification in work related courses.




Youth Entrepreneurs Network (YEN)
