We have provided over **100** one to one support through our employment, foodbank, training and community transport services.

Impact of our food delivery services this month;

- **52** families and **35** individuals were served.
- **553kg** of food. This is equivalent to
- **604** meals equivalent, and
- **977kg** of Carbon dioxide savings.
