OUR WORK IN THE COMMUNITY

We have provided over **207** one-to-one support across our services, including;

- 15 individuals were supported through our wellbeing services.
- 4 individuals received housing support
- 4 individuals received support through our core activities.

PROJECT UPDATES

Foodbank

This month we served:

- 42 families and 17 individuals with,
- 689 kg of food. This is equivalent to
- 221 meals equivalent, and
- 1791 kg of Carbon dioxide savings.

Community Transport

This month, this project had **78** engagements through our weekly shop and transport services. We have temporarily stopped our Tri-activity and wellbeing activities until further notice.

Refugee Women Empowerment

We provided **21** one to one services on this project. 5 of our participants received certification in Equal Opportunities Training, Business Development, and English language for catering services. We successfully engaged with 4 new participants whom we will be working with to enrol onto courses and to secure employment.

This month we gained **10** new participants who we are providing employment and entrepreneurial services.
